Bright indirect light is ideal, preferably from northeast or eastern exposure. If placed in south or western exposure, keep it away from direct sun to prevent leaf scorch or crispy leaf edges.



We recommend fertilizers like Espoma Organic Indoor! Houseplant Food, Jack's Houseplant Special, or Organic Plant Magic. These options provide essential nutrients to keep your plants vibrant and thriving.



SOIL

For tropical plants we recommend our Rooted Goods All-Purpose Potting Mix, Uncle Mike's Organic Potting Mix, or Espoma's Organic Potting Mix. All three options are great choices for ensuring healthy growth and thriving plants.



Allow the soil to dry almost completely between waterings to avoid root rot and overwatering. Use your finger to check the soil moisture, or use a moisture meter. Avoid misting the leaves, as Begonias are prone to fungal issues.

● TEMPERATURE

Maintain temperatures between 55-85°F (14-29°C). Avoid drafts or sudden temperature changes.



Watch out for powdery mildew and mealybugs. Ensure good air circulation and inspect new plants before introducing them to your collection.

PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Propagate through rhizome division in spring or stem cuttings with adequate humidity for successful rooting. Trim any dead or yellowing leaves to promote healthy growth and maintain its shape.



Begonia Edinburgh is safe for pets, but ensure they don't ingest large quantities.
